Adults are going back to school at Cuyahoga Valley Career Center

It's back-to-school time for the kids, but did you ever consider going back to school yourself? Cuyahoga Valley Career Center, located in Brecksville, offers adult education programming to prepare you to begin or further a career in health care. Programs that will provide training to obtain a credential in an allied health profession include: Dental Assisting, EKG Technician, Registered Medical Assistant and State Tested Nurse Aide. All of these programs include dynamic classroom learning and hands-on experience either in a classroom or clinical setting. You could become a Registered Dental assistant in just over nine months.

If you are already working in a laboratory setting or you are an RN or LPN, you might be interested in receiving a certification in phlebotomy. Phlebotomists work in a laboratory setting collecting blood samples for analysis. CVCC is offering an International Academy of Phlebotomy Sciences (IAPS) Phlebotomy Exam Review course on Saturdays this fall.

On the non-clinical side of health care, CVCC offers a Medical Administrative Specialist training program which prepares individuals to work in a medical office or health care facility. Train to perform a broad range of administrative duties including scheduling, receiving patients, establishing and maintaining medical records, billing, coding and other clerical duties. This four module program takes just over nine months to complete.

The health care industry in Northeast Ohio continues to grow and jobs are available if you have the right skills. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, while employment in other areas continues to fall, health care has added 368,000 jobs nationally over the past 12 months.
